



# JavaScript Instructor

## Overview

This part-time position is one of several instructor positions in the TAF Academy Quasar Program. All instructors will learn the TAF Academy academic model as well as perform in accordance to the norms of the TAF Academy Professional Learning Community. TAF Academy is a project based learning environment (PBL) that uses an authentic intellectual work (AIW) frame. Instructors will incorporate at least one long term project that is authentic. In addition, curriculum is expected to include formative assessments to ensure students understand the material, and instructors are expected to make any necessary adjustments based on those assessments. Instructors are expected to teach 10-12 students through the entire six months of the program.

Classes are at our TAF Academy School located in Kent. Classes run January 11, 2010 - June 11, 2010 and are offered Tuesday-Thursday 3:00pm-5:00pm.

## Responsibilities

1. Modify TAF's online JavaScript curriculum to fit the TAF Academy PBL/AIW academic model
2. Find other resources for students to absorb JavaScript
3. Teach 10-12 students how to program in JavaScript (client and server)
4. Administer formative assessments and modify instruction accordingly
5. Give students two classroom performance evaluations per year
