- TAF Academy Mission

The Technology Access Foundation (TAF) seeks professionals highly vested in public education to serve 2-year terms on the TAF Academy Network Oversight Committee. The function of this committee is to provide general oversight for current TAF Academy @ Federal Way Public Schools and to help plan the launch of four additional schools throughout Washington State.

The primary responsibility of the TAF Academy Network Oversight Committee is to consult TAF as we partner with school districts throughout Washington State to launch a network of five small schools. This includes consultation on the creation and growth of school culture, structures, instructional leadership and administration.

TAF believes the mission of TAF Academy should be stewarded by a diverse group of professionals that collectively represent a broad range of perspectives, from education to industry. To do so, the TAF Academy Network Oversight Committee will seat six committee members in its inaugural year (2008-2009) and will add six additional members over the course of the following year. At its capacity of twelve, the TAF Academy Network Oversight Committee will be made up of the following:

- 3 members from the education community
- 3 members from business and industry
- 2 members from local government or social and community services
- 2 parents/guardians of current TAF Academy students (nominated by principals)
- 2 members from the TAF Board of Directors

The ideal TAF Academy Network Oversight Committee member is someone who is inspired by the TAF Academy mission, shares our passion for high academic achievement for each student, can commit to attend periodic meetings, and wants to make a meaningful contribution of time to public education.
